

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Parliamentary Election for North Norfolk Constituency

- 1. An Election is to be held of One Member of Parliament for North Norfolk.
- 2. Forms of nomination for the UK Parliamentary Election may be obtained at Electoral Services, North Norfolk District Council, Holt Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 9EN from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
- 3. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the Acting Returning Officer, Electoral Services, North Norfolk District Council, Holt Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 9EN, or from the Electoral Commission website by visiting the link at The nomination form | Electoral Commission and where care should be given to ensure the correct forms are downloaded for elections following 7th May 2024
- 4. Nomination papers must be delivered **by hand** to the Acting Returning Officer at the address above, on any working day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10am and 4pm but no later than **4 pm on Friday**, **7th June 2024**.
- 5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 11.59pm on Tuesday 18 June 2024. Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
- 7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. You can apply for a postal vote online at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election and applications must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. You can apply for a proxy vote online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
- 9. Applications for a free Voter Authority Certificate (VAC) for anyone who does not have an accepted form of photographic Identification in order to vote at the polling station must be received by 5pm Wednesday 26th June. More information on the requirements of Voter ID can be found at www.north-norfolk.gov.uk/voterid
- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. If a person has lost/had stolen/damaged or destroyed their photo ID after the VAC application deadline of 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024 has passed, an application for an emergency proxy can be made before 5pm on polling day.
