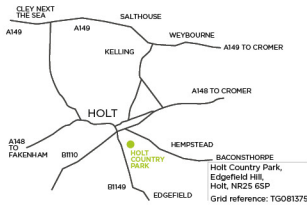
A fun two hour workshop for children of 11+ led by children's illustrator Peter Kavanagh.
